Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax
Nov. 8, 2022

Here are the projects to be funded by the proposed tax, broken down by municipality.

Savannah (\$143.5 million)

- Benton Boulevard widening (Tier 1 project): \$24.5 million
- Road resurfacing: \$20 million
- Local Roadway Congestion Mitigation Program: \$41.5 million
- Transportation-related Stormwater Improvement Program: \$7 million
- Transportation Safety/Signal Program: \$12 million
- Sidewalk Expansion and Maintenance Program: \$18 million
- Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety and Connectivity Program: \$10 million
- Traffic Calming Improvement and Expansion Program: \$7.5 million
- Bridge Repair Program: \$3 million

Port Wentworth (\$19.3 million)

- Benton Boulevard widening: \$7.3 million
- Road resurfacing: \$5.4 million

Pooler (\$31.8 million)
