Veterans Day is a U.S. legal holiday dedicated to American veterans of all wars. Veterans Day 2023 will occur on Saturday, **November 11** (observed Friday Nov. 10).

In 1918, on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month, an armistice, or temporary cessation of hostilities, was declared between the Allied nations and Germany in World War I, then known as "the Great War." The following year, many countries commemorated Armistice Day on November 11th. In 1938, it became a federal holiday in the United States. Later, in the aftermath of World War II and the Korean War, Armistice Day became known as Veterans Day.
