Our April Speaker: Tim Echols

Our upcoming speaker is PSC Commissioner and Vice-chair, Tim Echols. Echols is well known across the state now in his 15th year of service. Besides regulating energy and planning the power grid, Echols created TeenPact, the youth organization responsible for training over 100,000 students. He created this program in 1994 at the Georgia Capitol.

Echols jokes that he regulates energy by day, and fights crime by night. That is because he created the UnHoly Tour raising awareness about human sex trafficking. Echols started the tour in 2015 and uses it as a way to educate legislators and county commissioners about the blight that is human trafficking.

Echols is a big proponent of nuclear, and in 2017, he led the Commission through the Westinghouse Bankruptcy that almost brought the Plant Vogtle project to a permanent stop. Echols said nuclear energy is the way forward for America.

Echols and his wife, Windy, have seven children and four grandchildren. They live in Hoschton, GA and attend Prince Avenue Baptist Church in Athens. Echols has three degrees from the University of Georgia. He has a weekly radio show that airs on WTKS in Savannah on Saturday nights at 8pm. He is also the author of two books: *Real Citizenship*, and *Jean Marc of Jekyll*.
