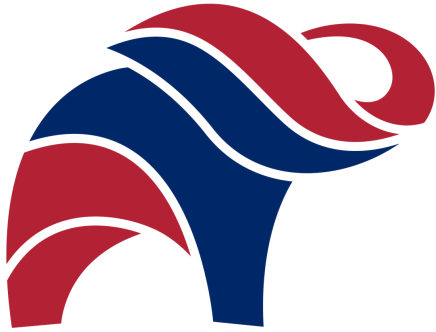

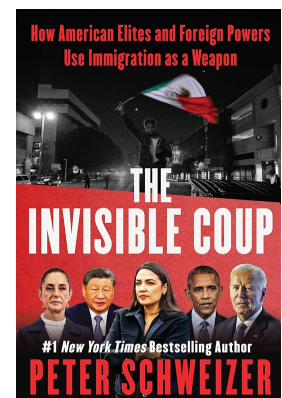

Under her direction, the office has undergone major technological upgrades—including digital ticketing, live-tracking wait times, and tag renewal kiosks—to reduce wait times. Her innovative community outreach includes launching a first-of-its-kind Mobile Tax Office to bring vital government services directly into local neighborhoods, an effort that helped earn her the prestigious Presidential Award from the Savannah NAACP.

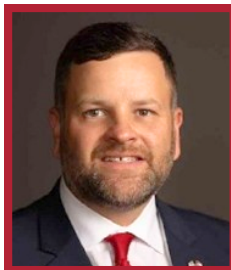
